The focus of the feedback surveys and this meeting is to review the summary report of the 2014 Plan and help set funding priorities for FY 2018-2022 transit improvements. The plan will also assist in selecting alternatives to improve specialized transportation services in the region, particularly for senior adults, people with disabilities, and individuals with low incomes. Federal and State guidance requires that funds for rural public and specialized transportation projects and services be derived from a locally developed plan that identifies needs and prioritizes projects for funding. It is vital that current and prospective applicants for these funds are involved in the planning process, and input from you and a wide range of stakeholders in the region is a key component in the development of this plan.
